Classroom News**Class A -- Mrs. Keefe-Mrs. Lawrence**

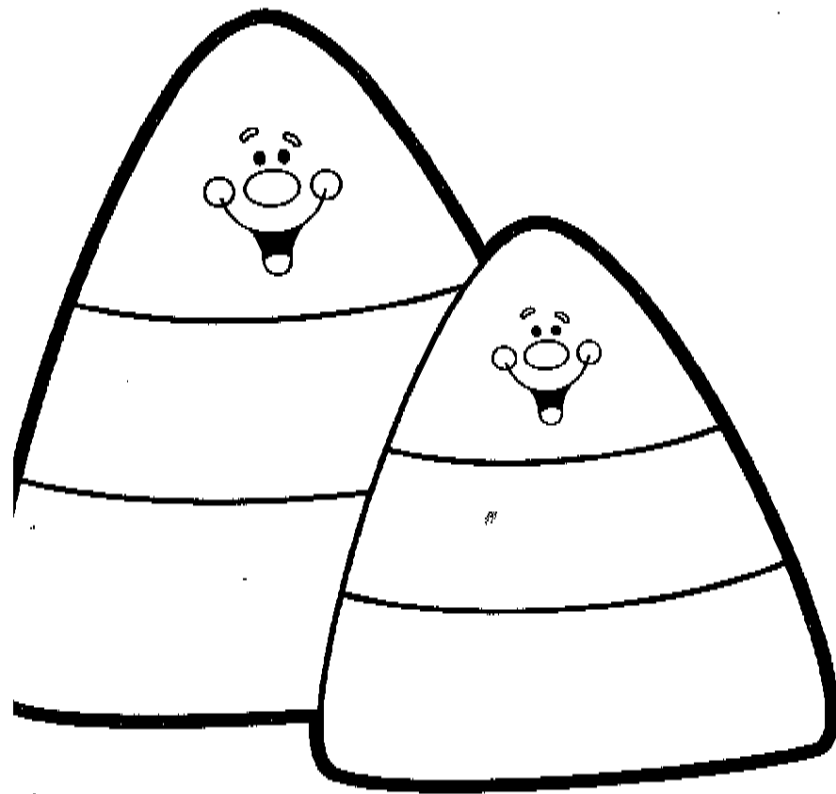
